

#### **BIRD'S MIGRATION**

Annually, several species of birds from south latitudes sail the skies, beginning in February, travelling through countries and continents, seeking favorable areas for feed in more agreeable latitudes. Several months later (between the end of Summer and the Fall), they return, making the same flight journey, but in the opposite path and with the same purpose. During these migration periods, throughout the entire Mirandese plateau several species can be watched, stopping their journey to feed and/or rest.

#### **PROGRAM OF ACTIVITIES:**

## 1<sup>rst</sup> day:

- Birdwatching;
- Guided tour to Miranda do Douro (built heritage and the Terra de Miranda Museum).

# 2<sup>nd</sup> day:

Birdwatching.

The program of activities will be held between **February** and **April**.

Birdwatching activity will be organized for groups with at least two adults and a maximum of eight people.

In nights of full moon and clean sky, *Moonwatching* (observing the passing of birds against the light of the moon) activities will also be held.

- Clothes and shoes suited to walking in the fields and adapted to according weather;
- Hat
- Binoculars;
- Field telescope and tripod;
- Camera;
- Notebook and pencil, or other means of recording your observations;

- Canteen with drinkable water.
