

#### **FORTRESSES ROUTE**

#### **DESCRIPTION:**

This itinerary was partially defined and characterized by the Douro International Natural Park.

Part of this course is made through granitic soils, with approximately 500 million years, near the *Arribas do Douro* (Douro Cliffs).

Along the itinerary, the arborous vegetation is significant, namely the more usual ones: Ashes (*Fraxinus angustifolia*), Prickly Junipers (*Juniperus oxycedrus*), Holm Oaks (*Quercus rotundifolia*), Pyrenean Oaks (*Quercus pyrenaica*) and some Cork Oaks (*Quercus suber*). The shrub layer is fairly large, in some areas.

In the open areas, the main human activity is the pastoralism, with emphasis on the exploitation of cattle breed *Mirandesa* and sheep breed *Churra Galega Mirandesa*, as well as donkeys from Miranda (Burro Mirandês), and familiar agriculture, with the exploration of the *Iameiros* (grazing pastures), cereal grain cultures, small farms and vines, and also some fruit trees, are the main human activities. Several birds species have a strong presence along the itinerary, namely the Black stork (*Ciconia nigra*), Griffon vulture (*Gyps fulvus*), Golden eagle (*Aquila chrysaetos*), Bonelli's eagle (*Aquila fasciata*), Peregrine falcon (*Falco peregrinus*), Eurasian eagle owl (*Bubo bubo*), Alpine swift (*Apus melba*), Red-billed chough (*Pyrrhocorax pyrrhocorax*), Black wheatear (*Oenanthe leucura*), Blue rock thrush (*Monticola solitarius*), Red kite (*Milvus milvus*), Montagu's harrier (*Circus pygargus*), Eurasian scops owl (*Otus scops*), among others.

The itinerary goes through the villages of Vale de Águia, Aldeia Nova, Paradela, Ifanes and Pena Branca.
