

SOLSTITIAL RITUALS AND NEW YEAR

Between Christmas and Twelfth Night, there are several villages in the Northeast of Trás-os-Montes that celebrate the Winter Solstice, and in the Mirandese plateau these solstice rituals are still very alive

With the unbearable cold of the winter season, it's necessary to rejoice and to be happy, and for that, nothing better than to discover the nature and the culture of Miranda do Douro, and welcoming the New Year in this jolly season.

PROGRAM OF ACTIVITIES:

1^{rst} day:

- Festa de San Juan (solstice ritual), in Constantim;
- Festival of Traditional Culture of Terras de Miranda Geada.

2nd day:

- Guided tour to Miranda do Douro (built heritage and the Terra de Miranda Museum);
- Pedestrian tour.

3rd day:

- Workshop of Mirandese traditional music;
- Donkey ride.

4th day

- MTB touring;
- New Year's Eve in a country house.

5th day (½ day):

Solstice ritual of the Menino and the Biêlha, in Vila Chã da Braciosa.

The program of activities will be held between the 28th of **December** and the 1^{rst} of **January**.

The donkey ride will be held in partnership with the *Associação para o Estudo e Proteção do Gado Asinino* (AEPGA) - the Association for the Study and Protection of Donkeys.
