DESCRIPTION:

This itinerary goes through the southwest area of Miranda do Douro, across the villages of Vale de Mira, Duas Igrejas, Silva, Fonte Ladrão, Granja, Uva, Vale de Algoso and Algoso. In this village, we can climb up to the castle, a national monument, which was built over a quartzite "castle", and delight ourselves with the magnificent landscape around us. The road back will be made passing through Teixeira, Atenor, Palaçoulo, a famous village in the art of cutlery and cooperage, going then to Águas Vivas and finaly to Miranda do Douro.

In this area of the itinerary, the Mirandese Plateau, with its mosaic of agricultural fields, *lameiros* (grazing pastures) and forest, is only disturbed by the close valley where the small river of Angueira runs, where we can watch the birds of the region, that at any moment can surprise us with moments of rare beauty.

- Church of Teixeira (XV century);
- Sanctuary of rock carvings of Fragas da Lapa (IV millenium a.C.);
- Church of Atenor:
- Rural Museum of Palaçoulo;
- Parish church of São Miguel, in Palaçoulo;
- Chapel of Nossa Sra. da Ascensão or of the Carrasco, in Palaçoulo (XVI century);
- Parish church of Sta. Catarina, in Águas Vivas.
